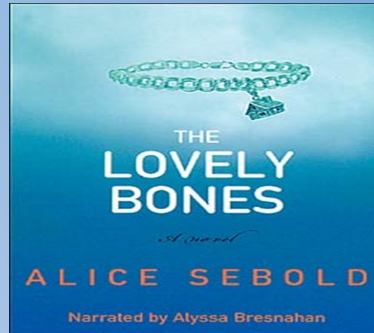

Entry Requirements: Grade 6 in English at GCSE Level

Course Description

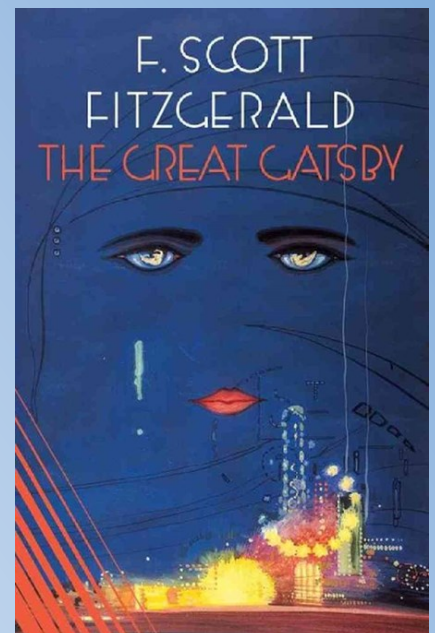
English Language and Literature is offered as an A level course which will appeal to those interested in reading, writing (creatively and analytically) and discussing what they read. The course involves the study of several works of literature such as 'The Lovely Bones', 'The Great Gatsby' and 'Othello' and a themed anthology of works of non-fiction, with a specific focus on the language used. The syllabus encourages wider reading and allows for the development of creative and analytical writing skills which are tested through a combination of pieces of coursework and examinations. A personalised coursework investigation allows to students to focus on texts and genres in which they have a particular interest.

Method of Assessment

80% external examination and 20% coursework.

Progression

A level English Literature and Language may lead to further study of the subject in Higher Education or support any number of courses where the skills of reading and writing are valuable. Journalism, the law, teaching and many medical fields are careers where effective analysis and writing are required. The subject is also considered very favourably by employers who recognise the high level of thinking, written and oral skills required by the course.



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
