	<h2>Aspiration</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ambition Optimism Resilience

As well as being assessed on their academic progress, our students will receive an Aspiration score, reflecting one of our school character traits.

Staff will consider their interactions with our students and provide a score between one and three for aspiration. A guide on the criteria can be found below.

Aspiration - *Ambition • Optimism • Resilience*

Score	Meaning	Observed Behaviours
3	Always Demonstrates	The student always demonstrates aspirational behaviour. They demonstrate ambition, optimism and resilience. The student responds well to teacher feedback and contributes to discussions in lessons.
2	Sometimes Demonstrates	The student sometimes demonstrates aspirational behaviour. On occasion, the student may have chosen not to participate in class discussions when asked to or respond to teacher feedback in a positive manner. The student may have also missed deadlines or demonstrated passive learning.
1	Does Not Demonstrate	The student does not display aspirational behaviour and may show little desire to be successful within the subject. The student does not participate in classroom discussions, does not response to teacher feedback and may demonstrate no desire to learn.
