#### Our values are to:



## Making the difference - 'The Barnwell Way'

## **Positive relationships:**

Relationships are integral to successful learning; this is our starting point and the key to igniting student growth and learning.

An absolute strength of Barnwell is the building of strong and positive relationships and understanding between staff and students. Acceptance and empathy foster mutual respect and contribute to providing the conditions for our students to flourish and grow in a safe and purposeful environment.

We know and understand our students, we use nurture principles to ensure that every child's needs are understood and met.

Student wellbeing is important to us; throughout the year our pastoral team support all students to ensure they are happy in school, and we work with our student ambassadors to understand, more, the needs and desires of our students. We actively listen to our students and parents and this knowledge shapes many decisions in school.

Across both campuses, we are consistent in our routines, creating secure environments where students take risks, learn from mistakes and grow.

'Even though the school is based on two sites, it feels like one school. Pupils benefit from consistent routines and a strong induction programme' (Ofsted 2021).

## **Building character:**

Even with the right conditions for learning, children still need motivation, encouragement and reward to be successful. Through **Character Education** our students learn how to intrinsically motivate themselves from a desire to 'do the right thing' rather than relying upon extrinsic motivation in the form of sanctions or material reward.

We support our students to build self-belief and become socially confident to grow and build character.

'Pupils want to do well in lessons, contributing well to class discussions, showing curiosity in the questions they ask. Pupils listen closely to their teachers in class' (Ofsted 2021).

Our students develop the ability to remain motivated by long term goals, see the link between effort and achievement and overcome and learn from setbacks by developing perseverance.

Learning and habituation of positive moral attributes / virtues, or, as we refer to them at Barnwell, 'characteristics' underpin this approach.

We know that students who realise and surpass their individual academic targets have developed these key characteristics - they have enabled a successful learning journey. The characteristics that we encourage in all of our students, through **Character Education**, are to be **respectful**, **responsible** and **aspirational**.

Opportunities to develop the characteristics are strategically planned to enable all students to demonstrate respect, responsibility and aspiration throughout their schooling. We challenge our students, every year, to earn character recognition and students who consistently display these characteristics are recognised at our annual Celebration evenings.

Social confidence enables our students to make points and debate robustly and constructively, listening attentively to the views of others, behaving with courtesy and good manners.

'Pupils are well mannered; they hold doors open for each other. Pupils behave well around the school' (Ofsted 2021).

Co-curricular opportunities sit alongside our taught curriculum; there is strong provision that is designed to focus on high quality activities across a wide spectrum of different interests. This provides our students with many opportunities to experience and master skills that complement or contrast their academic curriculum.
